Face2Face is a free service being hosted by Peterborough Breast Cancer Support Group – www.pbcsg.org.uk – to offer complimentary make-up sessions to women who have recently undergone treatment for a diagnosis of cancer. The aim is to give that *'feel good'* factor that's so often needed whilst going through cancer treatments.

Who can benefit from this?

Any woman who has had a recent cancer diagnosis (not just breast cancer) can benefit from this service, plus those women who may still be receiving treatment (surgery, chemotherapy or radiotherapy) even though they might have had their original diagnosis a while back.

How many sessions, how long and what will happen?

There is an opportunity for two sessions, one with a leading High Street brand and the other a salon who will use organic products. It's your choice whether you take advantage of just one or both sessions (which are held on separate days). Each session should last approximately two hours.

Do I need to take anything with me?

Yes, it would be helpful if you could bring along the make-up you currently wear, as the therapist can advise you on this. Make-up will be supplied and you'll learn techniques for day and evening wear. If you normally use brushes, it would be helpful if you could bring these along too, although brushes will be supplied if you don't use them.

You may want to consider bringing along a soft drink too.

Where will these sessions be held?

The venues include Serpentine Green and a salon off Eastfield Road. Further venues may be added at a later date.
